Soroptimist Members in Action Service Awards & Projects We Support

In September 2023, we presented several non-profit organizations with cash grants to support their programs that fit with the Soroptimist mission.

- Conejo Free Clinic for their mammogram fund for lowincome women who are underinsured or uninsured.
- James Storehouse is using this cash grant to purchase four bicycles, helmets and locks for women, which will give them safe, reliable and efficient transportation so they are able to pursue education, maintain work and get to appointments.
- Kids & Families Together who partners with Heart 2
 Heart will use the grant for their Resource & Kinship
 Family Support Center.
- RAIN Communities provides transitional housing to homeless women and their children. This cash grant will fund their transportation assistance while the women work to regain permanent housing and self-sufficiency.
- Soroptimist International of the Americas (SIA) for their Live Your Dream Awards: Education and Training for Women program.
- Our International project for CIFORD Kenya, to support their Girls in Leadership Initiatives program and to provide a new water conservation tank that enables families access to clean drinking water.

Throughout the year, we also participate in Community events and hands-on Service Projects which include:

- ⇒ Donated backpacks & school supplies to Heart 2 Heart and Kids & Families Together for foster & kinship families.
- ⇒ Tote bags filled with personal items were given to Heart House, a temporary shelter rescue home established by the local Interface Children & Family Services (Human Trafficking Response Program) for women who have been victims of domestic sex trafficking.
- ⇒ Clothing donations to **Safe Harbor**, an organization that works with Rape and Assault Victims and provides a safe place for medical exams and police interviews.
- ⇒ Dream It Be It program at **James Storehouse**, that provides resources to foster and at-risk youth.
